Workshop in English Language

The geological landscape is complemented by invisible patterns of life forces and elemental beings. How can its invisible dimensions be perceived? How do they transform in the condition of the complex city structures? Copenhagen area takes part in that aspect of the Europe's organism that can be compared with the throat chakra of the human body. How can the role of the throat chakra be experienced within the Copenhagen region? Which are its organs and power places? Do they function well, or do they need some touch of a healing ritual? Marko Pogačnik has developed proper tools for this purpose based upon the principle of art.

Marko Pogačnik lives in Šempas, Slovenia. Has worked in Conceptual Art and Land Art which he later combined with spiritual ecology called "geomancy". His books in English include: Turned Upside Down, Touching the Breath of Gaia, Nature Spirits & Elemental Beings, Sacred Geography, Gaia's Quantum Leap.
